Plant a Tree for Arbor Day

- Floresta hosts tree planting at Mount Acadia Park in San Diego

San Diego, Calif. – Floresta, the San Diego-based non-profit organization that has planted 3 million trees worldwide, is hosting a local Arbor Day event on Saturday, April 28, 2007 from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at Mount Acadia Park in Clairemont. Seven Golden Medallion trees will be donated for this community planting.

The event, co-sponsored by several local nurseries, will feature tree planting, remulching and park beautification. Shovels will be provided, but volunteers are advised to bring their own gloves and to wear comfortable clothing. Coffee and muffins will be provided.

All ages are welcome to this commemoration of the 135th anniversary of Arbor Day, founded to encourage Americans to plant a tree that beautifies their community. Floresta (www.floresta.org) is a Christian charity that continues to plant trees on five continents, working to halt deforestation and put an end to poverty in villages in Africa, Mexico, Haiti, Dominican Republic and Thailand.
